



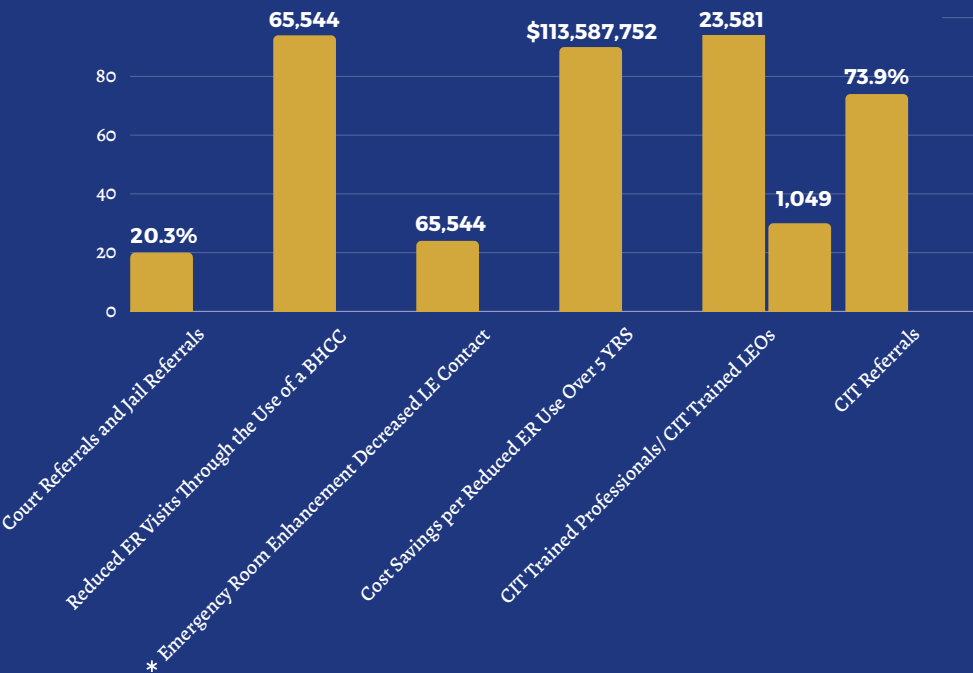
WHO WE ARE

We work together to strengthen Missouri’s CIT efforts through collaboration and shared expertise.

- Guide CIT Training & Curriculum development, expansion, and implementation
- Advocate for systemic change through policy and legislative recommendations
- Promote Health & Wellness for individuals in crisis and the first responders and professionals who serve them

- Coordinate statewide CIT efforts with support from the Missouri Department of Mental Health and the Missouri Behavioral Health Council
