



➤ About HOPE MDT Navigators

The HOPE Referral Program utilizes a HOPE MDT Navigator to provide intensive care coordination based on the ten principles of the wraparound process.

The program's goals are to ensure that the needs of the youth & their families are addressed, improve outcomes for youth with behavioral health disorders under the custody of the children's division, and establish ongoing relationships with multidisciplinary system partners.

➤ What HOPE MDT Navigators Do

Screening, connecting and monitoring of mental health services, substance use, intellectual developmental disabilities, crisis services, and other resources to support child wellbeing. HOPE MDT Navigator is assigned to each youth to work in conjunction with the youth's caseworker. Building relationships with the youth and family support team to support transitions. HOPE referrals provide the youth with priority entry into Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics (CCBHC). Support navigating the children's behavioral health system.

➤ Referrals Reason

- Mental health or behavioral concerns, substance use, intellectual developmental disability services, is in crisis, or needs resources for support.
- Youth is currently boarding in a hospital.
- Multi-system involvement/intensive care coordination.
- HOPE MDT Navigator assigned to each youth to work in conjunction with the child's caseworker.
